

BECOMING A ROMANS 12 TRAILMAN

JUNE TOPIC: Serve God by Serving Others Using the Gifts that He has Provided

Trailmen: God has provided gifts specific to each one of you. It is His will that you use these gifts to serve Him by serving others. God's gifts specific to each one that is a born-again Christian include:

- Spiritual Gifts
- Abilities and Talent
- Personalities and Passions
- Possessions

Spiritual Gifts

Many of the spiritual gifts are described in Romans 12:

⁶ We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; ⁷ if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; ⁸ if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead¹ do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.

Also, from 1 Corinthians 12 we read:

⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:

From the above verses, it is clear that if you are a born-again Christian, you have received at least one spiritual gift. We are commanded to use these gifts, working together, to lift up the Body of Christ, that is the Church. Greek for *profit of all* in the above verse is *sumphero* which literally means to "lift up together".

As you progress through Navigators to Adventurers, your spiritual gift(s) to serve the church may start becoming evident through the opportunities presented for service, effective results from service, leading of the Holy Spirit, recognition of your gifts by others, from God's Word, prayer and other evidences.
